**Entry fees:**

All classes **£10 per class** Except Championship classes **£15 per class**

Youth **£10 per class** or **£30 for 3 or more** Youth classes

**Closing date for Entries and Stable Bookings is Friday 6<sup>th</sup> August 2010.**

**For both late entries and new entries on the day there will be an additional £15 administration charge (this applies only to horses that have not pre-entered at least one class).** Late entries are any entries postmarked on or after the closing date.

**Stabling:**

**£60 per stable per weekend** (Thursday 10am - Sunday afternoon). If stabling is required for Sunday night, please indicate on your booking form and include an additional £20. **No stable bookings will be taken by the college** and all bookings must be via the Society. Bedding in all stables is Flax. First bedding will be provided in each stable. Additional bales can be purchased from the Secretary at the show. All stable allocation is done by the college. Please note on your entry form if you have any special requirements. **Stables must be pre-booked by Friday 6<sup>th</sup> August.**

Subsidised stabling - If you are traveling over 200 miles to the WES National Show then your stabling cost will be reduced to £30 for the three nights. The distance is based upon the travel distance from your home address (as given in your WES membership) to Moreton Morrell and based upon the mileage as given by Google Maps.

Please note that permanent stabling is limited and no temporary stables will be provided, so stables will be allocated on a first come basis. Stables will be monitored by the Stable Manager over the week-end. Please ensure stables are left clean and tidy at the end of the show. Any competitor failing to leave their stable in a fit state will be charged £25 and may be prevented from attending future shows.

**UKPHA Summer Show** – Stables and classes must now be booked through WES. Registration and membership paperwork must be submitted with the entry. ### Conditions of entry

1. Neither the Western Equestrian Society, Warwickshire Agricultural College, nor the Show Management shall be responsible for any loss, damage, or expense incurred to any person or horse at the show from whatever the cause arising. All entries shall be at the sole risk of the competitor.
2. All objections must be made in writing to the show manager, and must be received on the day of the show, accompanied by a deposit of £10 which will be returned if the objection is sustained.
3. The organisers, at their own discretion, may at any time, before or during the show, reject any entry whether the same has been accepted or not, and their decision in this respect, without giving any reason, shall be final. The organisers shall have the power to eject from the showground any person whose behaviour they consider to be objectionable.
4. No unauthorised person may enter a ring.
5. There will be no return of entries incorrectly submitted.
6. All entrants into WES classes should be conversant with the rules of the Western Equestrian Society. Neither the Society nor the organisers will be held responsible for the failure of any competitor in understanding the rules.
7. Competitors must ensure they have adequate third party insurance cover.
8. Horse riding can be a dangerous sport. Please be responsible.
9. British standards approved hard hats are mandatory for Youth competitors under 14. Youth competitors over 14 may wear Western hats, subject to a disclaimer signed by a guardian being handed to the show secretary prior to their first class. British standards approved hard hats are optional in all classes.
10. Riders choosing to ride with a Western hat, do so at their own risk.
11. Children must be supervised at all times. Parents of children not found to be supervised and causing inconvenience may be asked to leave the showground.
12. Dogs must not be allowed to roam free on the show ground at any time.
